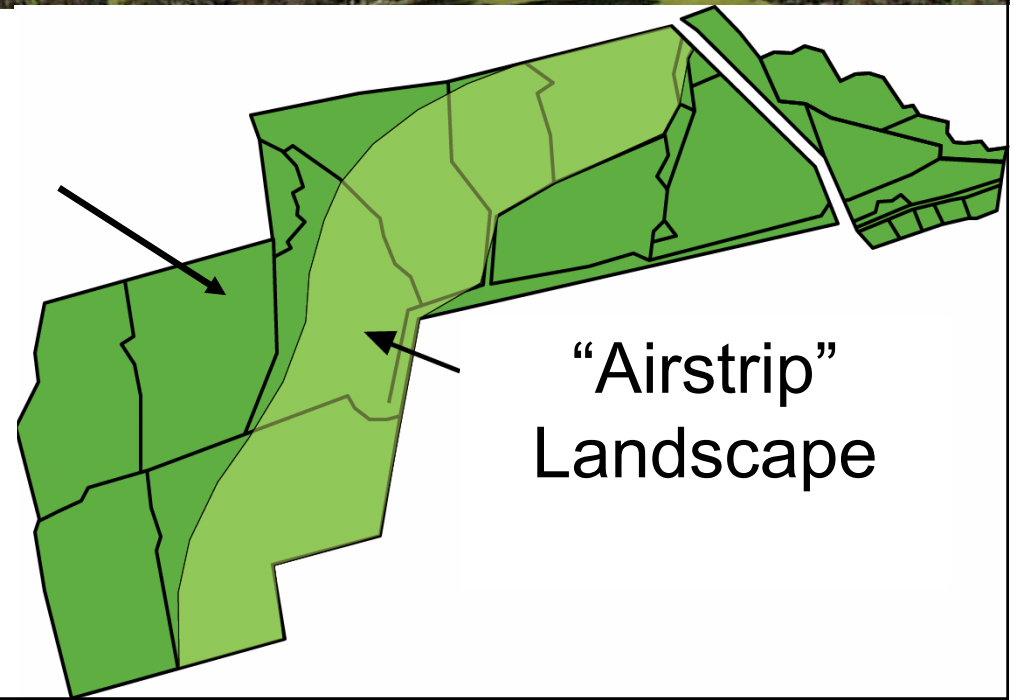

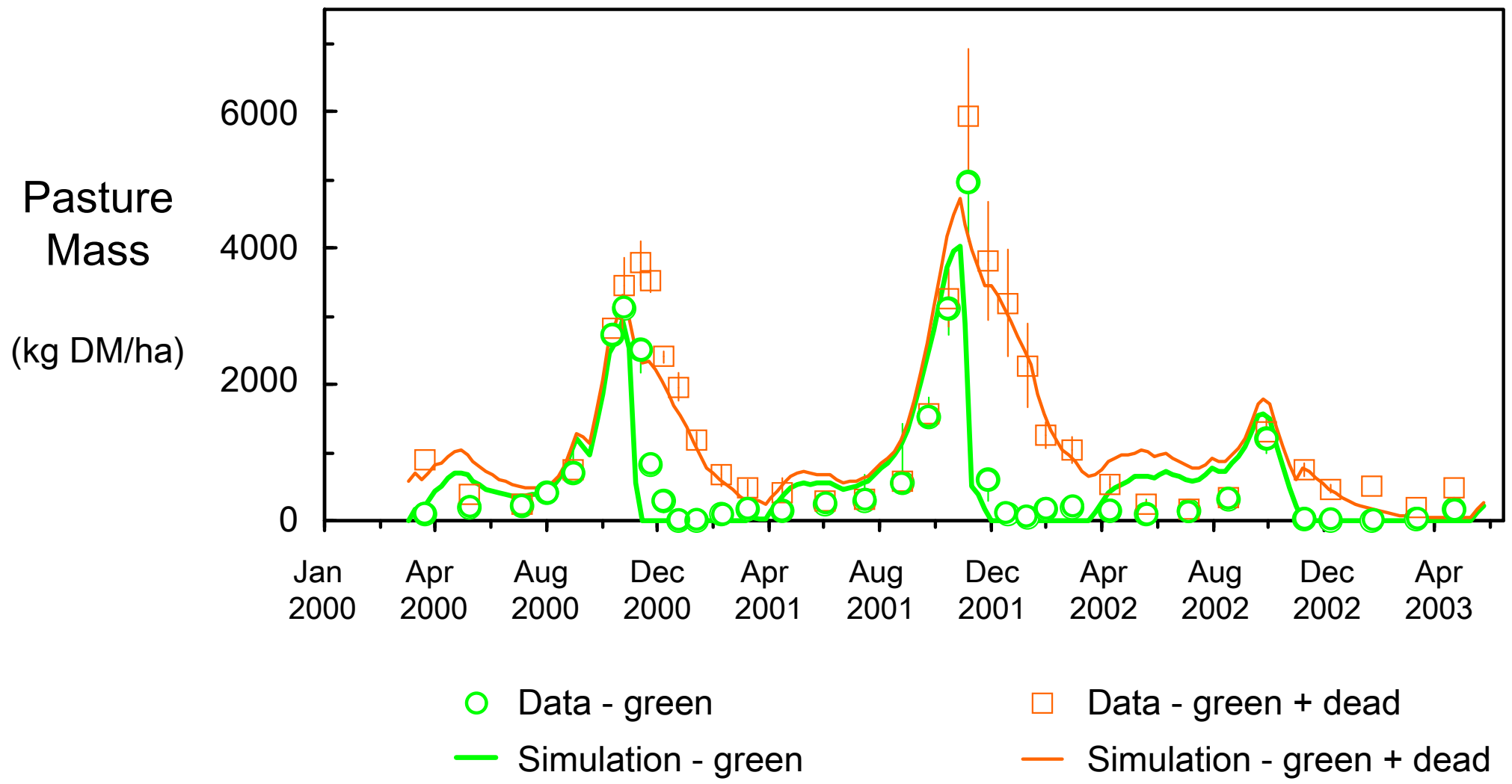

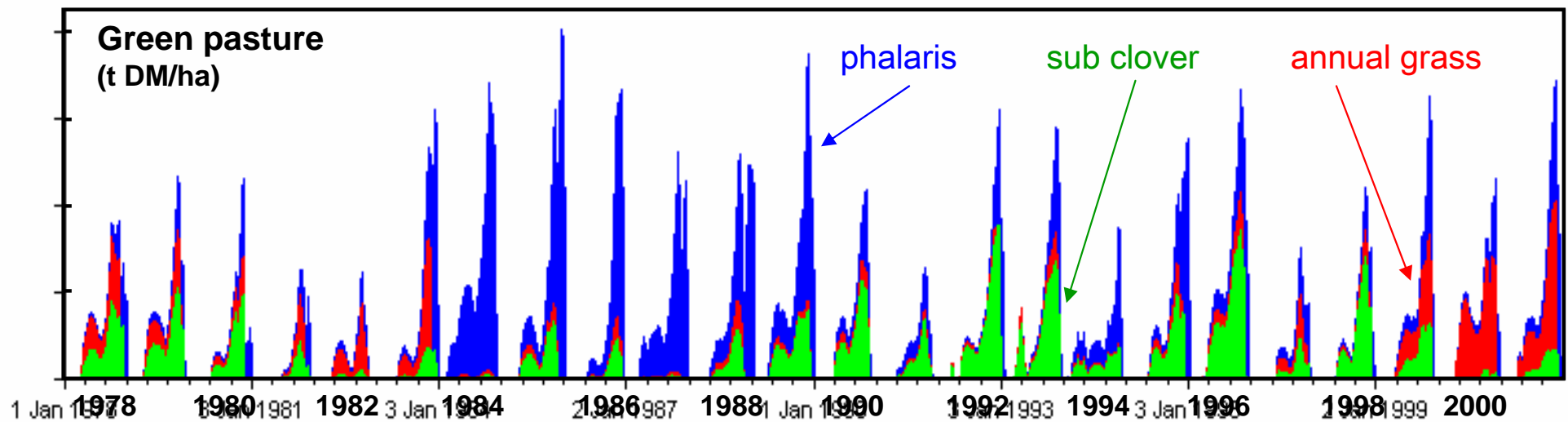

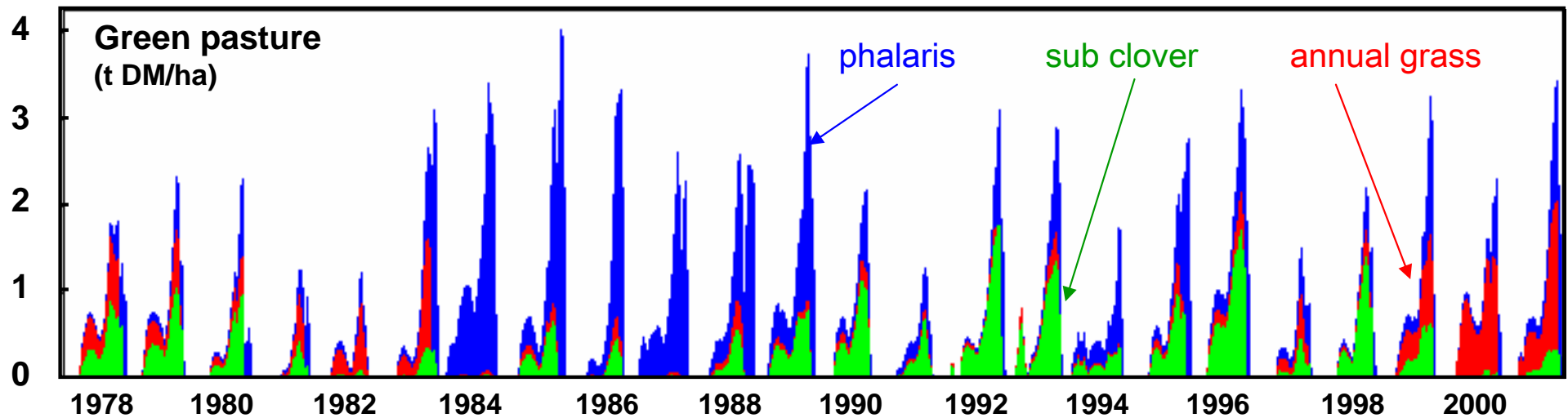
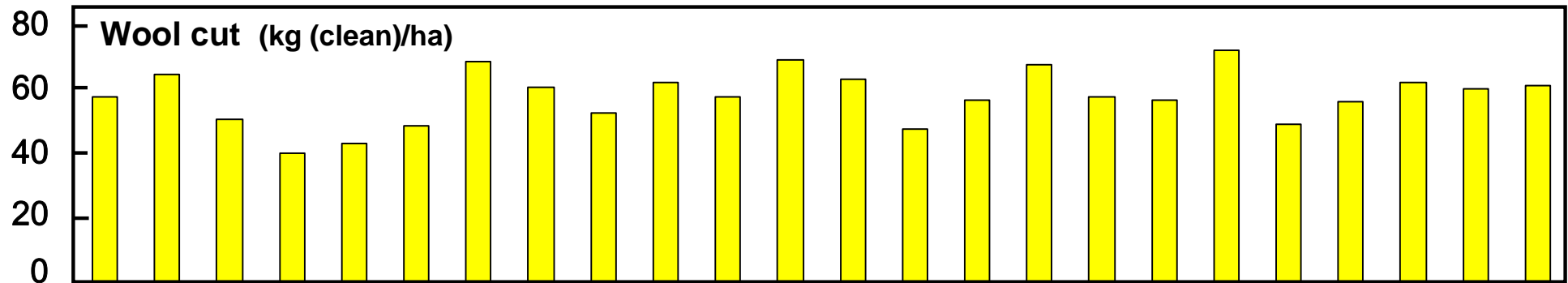


Simulation of pasture supply on “Curse” landscape

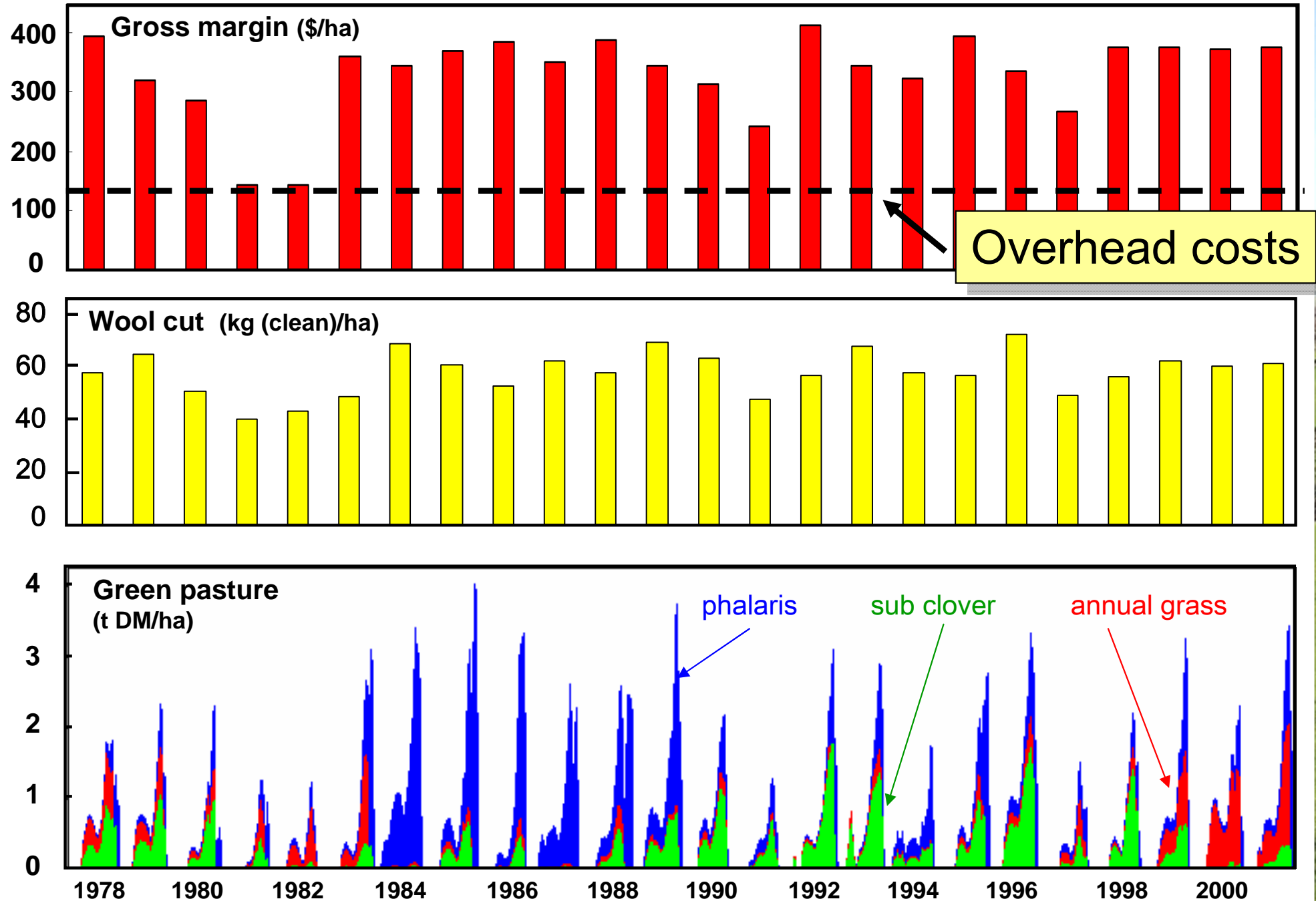

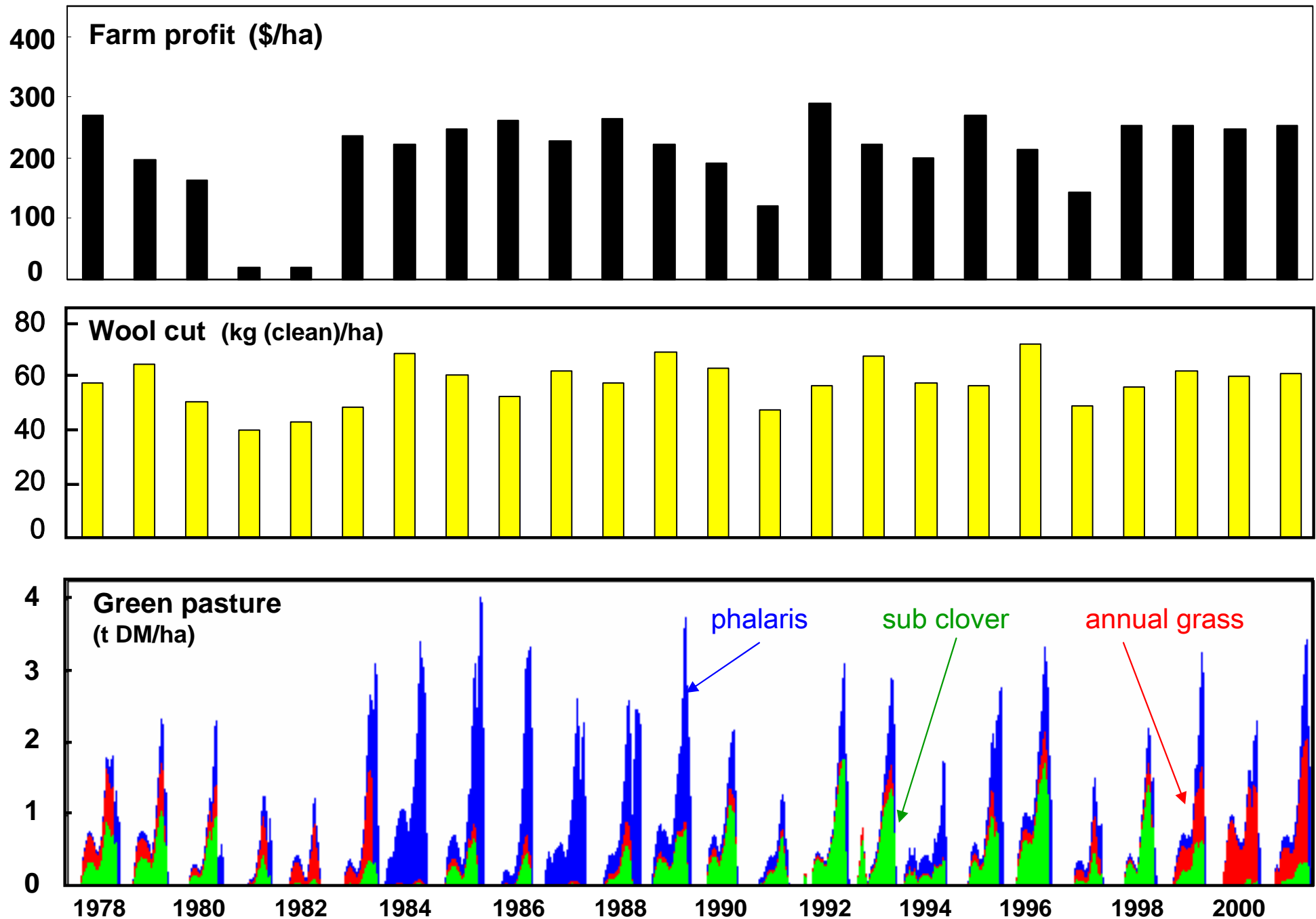

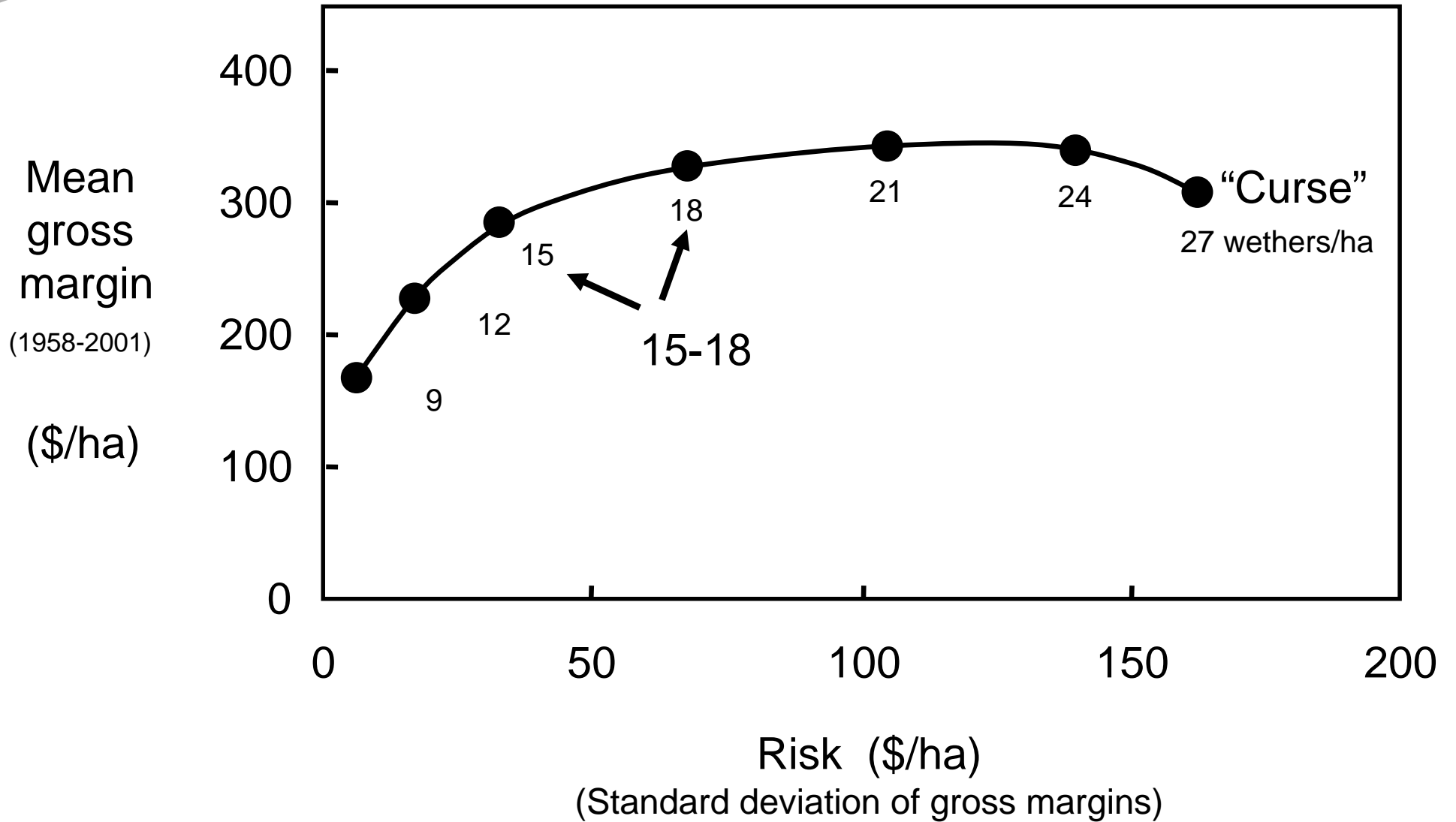

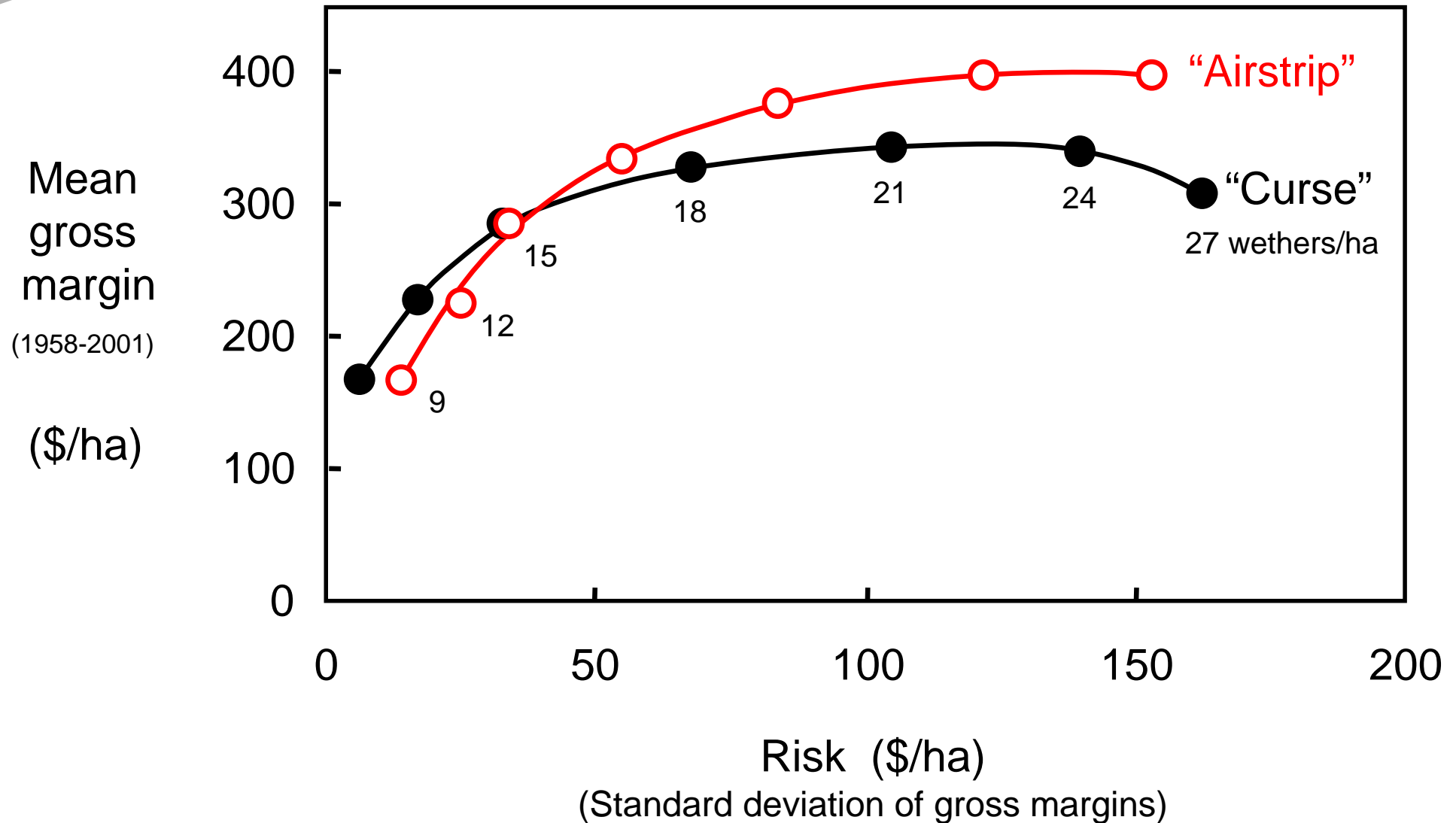

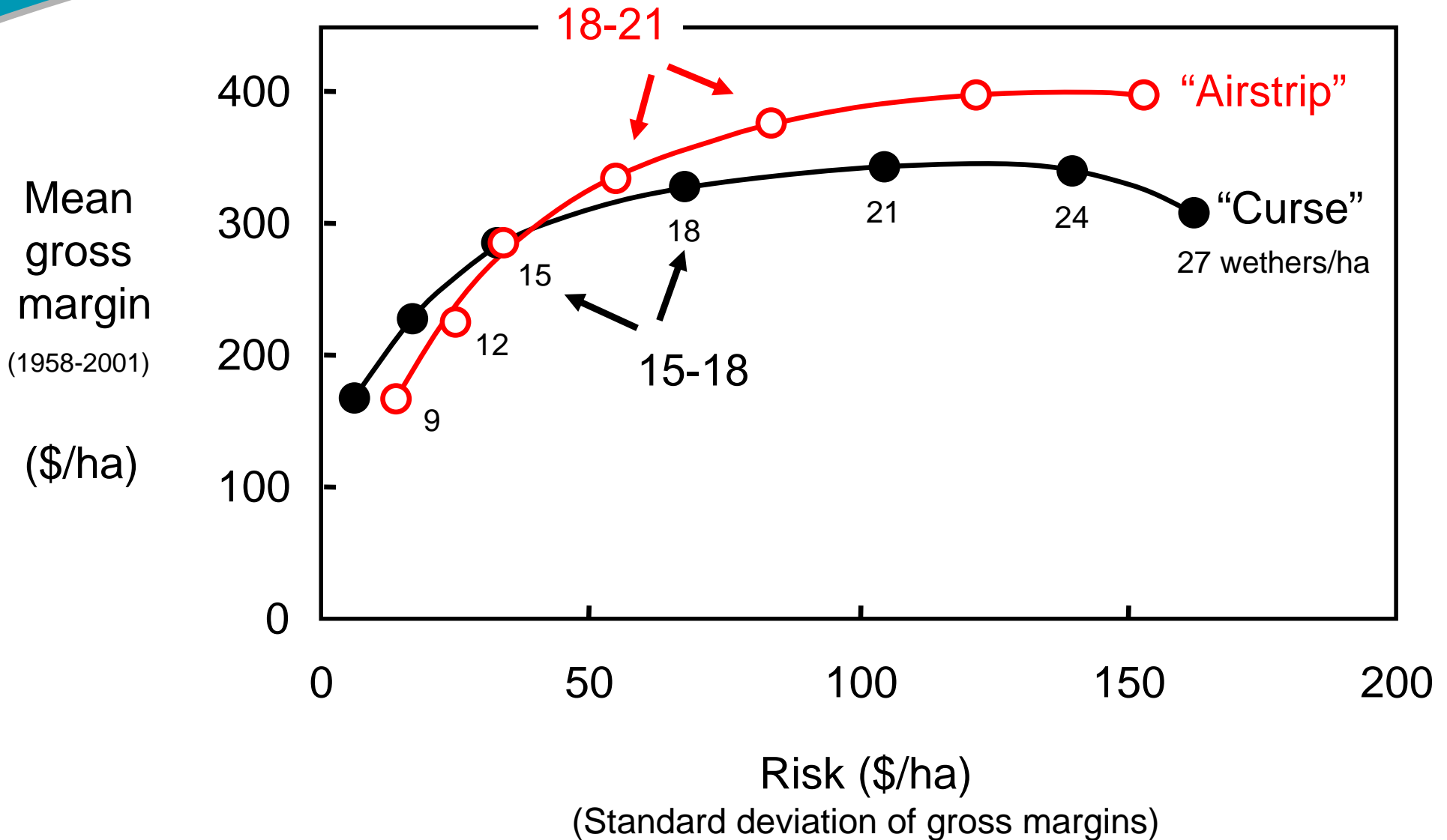
